The Boca Raton Historical Society Announces the Release of a “Tear-Out “ Postcard Booklet

Boca Raton, FL ... The Boca Raton Historical Society is pleased to announce the release of a new “tear-out” postcard booklet published by Arcadia Publishing in cooperation with the Historical Society. The booklet, compiled by BRHS archivist Susan Gillis from the Historical Society’s unique photographic collection, contains fifteen actual black and white postcards which can be removed from the booklet and used for mailing or framing or simply enjoyed as a book. Many of the images are actually reproductions of historic postcards of Boca Raton scenes such as the Boca Raton Club and downtown Boca Raton ca. 1950. In addition, charming images from Boca Raton’s pioneer era capture a much simpler Boca Raton—hard to imagine with twenty-first century eyes.
